The Grand Jury of the County of Bronx, by this indictment accuse defendant ,

of the CRIME OF ARSON IN THE SECOND DEGREE,

committed as follows:

The said defendant , acting in concert with others,

in the County of Bronx, on or about February 17, 1980 did intentionally damage the building located at 398 East 152nd Street by starting a fire therein at a time when another person, not a participant in the crime, was present in said building, the said defendant being aware of the fact

SECOND COUNT:

And the Grand Jury Aforesaid, by this indictment, further accuse said defendant , of the crime of ARSON IN THE SECOND DEGREE,

committed as follows:

The said defendant , acting in concert with others,

in the County of Bronx, on or about February 17, 1980 did intentionally damage the building located at 398 East 152nd Street by starting a fire therein when another person, not a participant in the crime, was present in said building, under circumstances which rendered the presence of such a person a reasonable possibility.

THIRD COUNT:

And the Grand Jury Aforesaid, by this indictment, further accuse said defendant , of the crime of RECKLESS ENDANGERMENT IN THE FIRST DEGREE,

committed as follows:

The said defendant , acting in concert with others, in the County of Bronx, on or about February 17, 1980 did, under circumstances evincing a depraved indifference to human life, recklessly engage in conduct which created a grave risk of death to another person in that defendant did set a fire in the occupied building located at 398 East 152nd Street.
